Provide effective and timely activities to assist students who have difficulty mastering the proficient or advanced levels of academic achievement standards.



## **SMART Goals**

It is our goal that each grade will have at least 70% of its students exceed a year's growth in reading and math on the NWEA MAP tests.

It is our goal that 60% of our students will receive a composite score of 17 or higher on the ACT. Also, it is our goal that the average ACT score will increase to a 17.



## **Rapid Improvement Indicators**

Instructional Teams meet for blocks of time to develop and refine units of instruction and review student learning data. They also develop standards-aligned units of instruction, use data to plan instruction, are guided by a document that aligns standards, curriculum, instruction, and assessment, and maintain a record of student mastery. Teachers develop weekly lesson plans based on aligned units of instruction.

The curriculum for all grade levels includes lessons on the accomplishments of Native Americans and the school provides training for all staff on local tribal history, culture, customs, and values.
