SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

ADMINISTRATION:

These scholarships shall be granted under the direct supervision of the Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation Board of Directors.

A committee composed of one member of the WyFB Board of Directors, an appointee of the WyFB Board of Directors, and a member of the Herbert D. Livingston family (selected by the Livingston family) has been established by the Board of Directors to select the winners of the King-Livingston Scholarships, the Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation Scholarships and the WyFB Continuing Education Scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

The WyFB Board of Directors has determined that:

1. \$600 from the Livingston Foundation and \$150 from the King Fund shall be combined to provide a single scholarship totaling \$750. Only the interest earned from the fund principal will be used to finance the scholarship awards. Any unused amount of interest earnings not used for the King-Livingston scholarship awards at the end of the fiscal year of the Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation, will be converted to principal and become part of the principal.
2. Five \$500 scholarships under the name, "Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation Scholarships",
3. Three new \$500 scholarships under the name, WyFB Continuing Education Scholarships".

All WyFB and WyFB Continuing Education scholarships are administered by the same selection committee as the King-Livingston Scholarship.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Applicants family must be a **CURRENT** member of **Wyoming Farm Bureau** organization (Having an Insurance policy with Mountain West Farm Bureau does not qualify as a Wyoming Farm Bureau Membership.)
2. Applicant must have either graduated from a Wyoming high school, or be in the graduating class of a Wyoming high school when application is submitted.
3. Applicant must be enrolled at either a Wyoming Junior college or the University of Wyoming at the time the scholarship is granted.
4. College freshmen, sophomores, juniors, seniors or graduate students are all eligible to apply. For the Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation Scholarships, applicants who will be in grades 13 through 18 are eligible to apply.
5. Applicants for the **WyFB Continuing Education Scholarships** must submit at least two semesters of college grade transcriptions. Freshmen must submit first semester grades and proof of enrollment in second semester.
6. Application must be received by March 1, at the office of the Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation, 931 Boulder Dr., Laramie, Wyoming 82070
7. The application form must be accompanied by a grade transcript, resume of applicant's family activity with Wyoming Farm Bureau including a **CURRENT** membership, a recent photograph, (no computer copies please) and three letters of recommendation, one letter from each of the following: a church leader, a Farm Bureau leader, and a school teacher or administrator stressing the applicants ability, character, and financial need.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENT:

The selection will begin May 1 of each year. The recipient will be notified as soon as possible thereafter.

The presentation of the award will be made to the recipient by mail from the Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation state office in the form of a check for the amount of the scholarship, made payable to the recipient and the college or university they have enrolled or are attending. This check will be issued upon the "timely" receipt of verification of enrollment from the scholarship winner. If not claimed in a timely manner the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate.

The following guidelines are established:

1. The selection will be on a deserving basis; however, the winner must have at least a 2.5 scholastic grade point average based upon a 4.0 scale.
2. No one will be disqualified because of sex, race, color, creed or religious beliefs.
3. The King-Livingston scholarship winner may also be the recipient of the Wyoming Farm Bureau award or the WyFB Continuing Education award if so selected.
