- Transcripts for incoming freshmen.
- **Complete print out of academic record from *Hole in the Wall* for current majors.**
- One page statement of interest in art, or brief philosophy
- Three reference letters must be submitted with application for incoming freshmen and transfer students only. **List of 3 faculty references if current major in Art Department**

Recipient MUST CONTINUE as a full-time status BA/BFA art major in order to be eligible for art department scholarship support. Recipient MUST CONTINUE as a full-time status BS art education major in order to be eligible for College of Education scholarship support.

College of Arts and Sciences Scholarships for BA/BFA Art Majors Only:

CONRAD SCHWIERING WESTERN FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP - Amount varies

Preference: student who resides in Wyoming, interest in traditional western landscape art.

DONALD WIEST FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP -\$1,000 Award

Eligible: UW Junior or Senior

LUCILLE WRIGHT FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP - Amount varies

Eligible: UW undergraduate

ROBERT D. COE FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP - Several awards; Amount varies

Preference: painting, drawing, or printmaking. All incoming freshmen, transfers, and currently enrolled studio art majors.

FELL-OSKINS FINE ART SCHOLARSHIP - Several awards; amount varies

Any currently enrolled University of Wyoming studio art major. Award based upon academic achievement.

Preference: student whose residence is in Park, Big Horn, Hot Springs, or Washakie counties of Wyoming.

1. PORTOFOLIO:

- * 10-20 mounted slides of art work; in a plastic slide sheet.
 - * 10 art works maximum; option for in-coming Freshmen ONLY
- Label all slides with your name, title, medium, size and date.
Place a red dot in the lower left corner for proper viewing.***

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING SLIDES: *Quality is the most important criteria..*

- * select your best work
- * select work which demonstrates the level of your conceptual and aesthetic understanding and development.
- * select work done independently or created for course work.
- * select work done at UW and/or from other post secondary schools, if an option.
- * select work in one medium or from several different studio areas.
- * Give yourself enough time to properly photograph your work. Make sure that the slides clearly show the work. Color shifts, unfocused images and overemphasis on the background detract from your efforts to represent your work in slide format. Guides to photographing artwork are available in the art office.

2. STATEMENT: (Typed-one page):

Discuss your interest in pursuing an art degree and also state your professional goals.

3. ACADEMIC RECORD:

Minimum 3.0 GPA required of current majors. Equivalent for high school and transfers.

Official transcript for incoming freshmen and new transfers.

*****Complete transcript printout from Hole in the Wall for current UW majors.***

4. REFERENCES: Three reference letters must be submitted with application.

This applies only to incoming freshmen and transfer students.

*****List of 3 faculty references if current major in the art department.***
